FESTIVAL PRELUDE ON NOW THANK WE ALL OUR GOD

Program note by Robert Sirota:

The Festival Prelude on Now Thank We All Our God (1985) was commissioned by the First Parish Church of Brunswick Maine for that church's restored 19th century two-manual tracker organ. The premiere performance was given by Victoria Sirota at the concert rededicating the organ. For this classic instrument, built in the latter half of the nineteenth century, I wrote a work that pays homage to the New England church composers of that era, most particularly Dudley Buck (1839-1909).
